Greetings, Parents and Guardians!

As we move into nicer weather (hopefully!), I do want to remind you of a few school rules.

- Students should wait outside for school to officially open at 7:15. (Family Handbook, p. 5) We have allowed students to enter early in bad weather, but when it is warmer and dry, they should gather outside. Students should be in the classrooms before 7:45 (p. 6) so they can be “ready to go” on time!
- Hair may not be unnaturally colored. (p.13) This includes extensions. Multicolored hair causes distractions and competition, neither of which is helpful in school.
- Walking shorts may be worn from April 1 to Oct. 1 (p. 13)
- Field trips are a privilege, but also are part of the curriculum. Students should be permitted to attend unless behavior is an issue. Students should NOT be kept home from field trips for a “free day.” The school is paying for tickets, buses, and admission fees for your student.
- Car riders need to be picked up in the back lot; parking in front is a hazard to walkers and other drivers.
