Seventh graders need to have the **meningococcal immunization by Oct. 4** or we are mandated by the state to exclude them from school. We have not had to do that for any child YET – we wouldn't want your 7th grader to be the first!

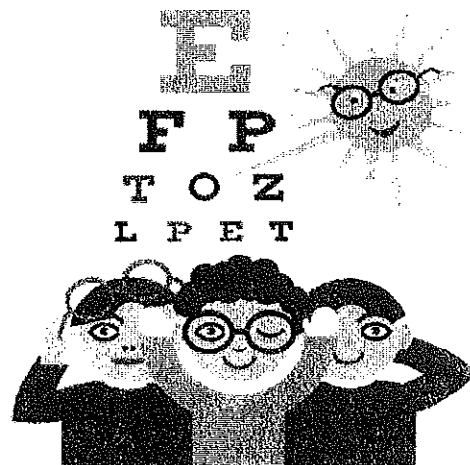
