Greetings, Parents and Guardians!

By now Labor Day is a thing of the past, and school is in full swing. We did have to get a new operating system for the school this past summer—Option C—so progress reports, report cards and other computerized information coming to you will have a different look. You can still get into the system to see your student's progress (grades, etc.) however, but it will be a different login. **Directions are included in this folder. If you have trouble getting into the system, please let us know. We are still learning our way around it as well, but we will get back to you as soon as we can!**

We are still in need of immunization records for some students. All students in Kindergarten and 7th grade, as well as all new students, need to have an updated immunization record on file in school to ensure that we are compliant with the State of Ohio. If we are not compliant by a certain deadline, we may need to exclude your child from school (hate to have that happen!). We keep trying different ways of making sure children get breakfast but still get to classes on time (that's a tough one!). Breakfast is served from 7:15 to 7:35. We will, however, require all students to **leave the cafeteria by 7:50**. Specials (art, music, PE, computer) and classes start at 7:55, and they must be there. Students riding buses that are late, are, of course, excused. We'll get them fed and to class ASAP.

Speaking of food, I am distressed seeing the number of students who bring food from home, especially Lunchables, and throw nearly all of it in the trash. Similarly, many students, all grades, pick up hot lunch here and dump all or nearly all of it in the trash. PLEASE talk with your student about their eating here at school. They are welcome to bring their own lunches if they don't like our menus. I just hate to see them wasting food, or your money.
