While this will be our last Thursday Folder until December 3, I do plan on sending out a newsletter on Tuesday next week, before we leave for break. I am hoping by now you have received and looked at yesterday's very important email regarding remote learning to begin after Thanksgiving. I can not stress enough what a difficult decision it was to make. For those who have not yet read yesterday's special announcement, it is also included in this week's Thursday Folder. While the time off seems lengthy, remember that the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday breaks are also included in that time. Actual remote learning amounts to three full weeks. Please read the enclosed letter for more details (it is the same letter that was emailed yesterday).

Teachers will be sending books and devices home between the two days next week so that it will not be too much to carry, all at once, on Tuesday.
